The Carbondale Mountain Fair is 41 years old and just keeps getting better. Carbondale Mountain Fair features 130 artisans from around the country, 22 food booths and three days of live music. The fair is an homage to the arts in all expressions. Last year we broke all attendance records and we expect that to continue this year. We open at noon on Friday. We pride ourselves on having high quality, unique arts and crafts. Please read all the rules and restrictions so we can continue to bring the best in arts to the Mountain Fair.

Mountain Fair is a juried show and we are continually looking for the best combination of arts. We have a "Family Area" with lots of interactive, creative experiences, and entertainment and competitions that run the gamut from cake baking to wood splitting and as always...free admission. Over 300 volunteers come together to make this one of the most unique fairs in the state.

Rules and Regulations

1. **ELIGIBILITY:** Any artist or craft person exhibiting his or her OWN HANDMADE WORKS OF ART (Not manufactured, not imported.) Any community service, civic, or social organization, or educational institution selling only its own works of art. Criteria for judging include quality and uniqueness of item(s).

2. **FEES:** Checks or money orders, made payable to Carbondale Mountain Fair. The fees must be paid in TWO SEPARATE CHECKS. Do not staple. Regular Arts/Crafts: \$20 Jury Fee and \$350 Space Fee. Hands-On Kids' Activities, Psychics, Massage, Pre-Packaged Foods: \$20 Jury Fee and \$100 Space Fee (plus 15% commission on gross sales at fair.) The Jury Fee is non-refundable. The Space Fee will be deposited upon acceptance - April 4, 2011. The Booth Space Fee is non-refundable after April 27th. If you are not accepted into the Fair, your fee will be returned (provided you include correct postage and SASE.)

3. **DIGITAL FILES:** Submit 4 digital photos which are representative of your work and reflect your price range (showing lowest, middle and highest prices, if possible.) Name must be

on each file. This is very important! and indicate price and size of each piece shown. Digital images may be emailed to: artwork@carbondalearths.com and must be SAVED AS JPEG files with the artist's name in the file name. Prices and sizes of artwork in digital images should be indicated in the text of the email.

4. **BOOTH CONSTRUCTION:** A 10' X 10' Booth space ONLY is provided. All necessary building material is the responsibility of the exhibitor. Note: THERE IS NO ELECTRICITY.

5. **SHARED BOOTHS:** Up to three artisans may share a booth. If the media are different, you must apply in COMBINED CATEGORIES and submit at least one digital photo of each category.

6. **PLEASE WRITE THE NAME OF YOUR MEDIUM:** (clay, leather, wood, clothing, metal, etc.) for which you are applying on the front lower left-hand corner of the envelope that includes your application, plus a BRIEF sub-description. Example: wood- furniture; wood - toys; clothing - painted; clothing - woven; jewelry - gold, sterling silver, non-metal.
